 Granting to the Ottoville Gas & Oil Company the right and privilege of the use of the Streets, alleys and public grounds of the Village of Ottoville, in Putnam County, Ohio for supplying said Village and its inhabitants with natural or manufactured gas and fixing the price to be charged therefor.
 Section one Be it Ordained by the Common Council of the Village of Ottoville O in Putnam County, Ohio, J. J. Miller, Joseph Wannenmacher, Nicholas Lauer, Jack Gillen, John Min Kelman, John Min Kelman, Jacob Wannenmacher, Ed Snyder, Ed Miller, E. Stalrup and M. J. Lytle, their associates, Successors and assigns, as individuals or as a body, corporate under the name of the Ottoville Gas and Oil Company are hereby granted the exclusive privilege and right of laying, maintaining, repairing and taking up of the necessary pipes, drops, regulators and other devices necessary for supplying the said Village of Ottoville and its inhabitants with natural and manufactured gas for heating, power manufacturing and illuminating purposes for twenty years (20 years).
 Section II All excavations and work for such use of said Streets, alleys and public grounds shall
