UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE DIRECTOR OF HIGHWAYS

WHEREAS, The Director of Highways is considering the matter of snow and ice  
removal under his supervision of the State or Federal Highway (s) in Ottoville

WHEREAS, (U) S. R. # 224; S.R. #66; and #189 within this village (ice is  
in whole or part)

WHEREAS, It is proposed to remove snow and ice on said State Highway, or Federal  
Highway into, within or through this village along the aforesaid State or Federal Routes.

NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Ordained, by the Council of the Village ~~City~~ of Ottoville  
State of Ohio.

SECTION 1: That it is declared to be in the public interest that the consent of  
said village be, and such consent is hereby given, that said (U) S. R. # 224; S.R. #66 & #189  
as described may be cleaned of snow and ice under the supervision of the Director of  
Highways.

SECTION 2: That the Clerk be, and he is hereby directed to furnish to the Director  
of Highways and to the Board of County Commissioners of Putnam County, Ohio,  
a certified copy of this Ordinance immediately upon the taking effect thereof.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after  
the earliest period allowed by law.
