

ORDINANCE NO 62

An emergency ordinance enacted by the Village of Ottoville, Putnam County, Ohio, in the matter of the hereinafter described improvement, under the supervision of the Director of Highway .

SECTION I (CONSENT)

WHEREAS, the Director of Highways is considering the matter of the following improvement under his supervision of the public highway particularly described as follows:

(Description)

Main Street (U.S. 224) from Winkleman St., to West Canal St., Third St., (U.S.224) From West Canal and Franklin St. Junction to the Little Auglaise River (West Corporation Line). Wayne St. (S.R. 66) from Third St. to the Southwest Corporation Line, Third St. (S.R. 189) from West Canal St. to Winkleman St.

The treatment on above streets will be item T-32 Bituminous Road Mix Surface course consisting of 0.97 gal. per sq. yd. Bituminous Material; 80 lbs #46 stone for mix; 9 lbs. #9 stone choke; 20 lbs #6 stone for seal. Approximately 2000 gal. prime material will be required.

and

WHEREAS, it is declared to be in the public interest that the consent of the Village of Ottoville, Ohio be given for above described improvement, under the supervision of the Director of Highways in accordance with plans, specifications and estimates as prepared by said Director.

NOW THEREFORE, such consent be and is hereby given, for the construction of the above described improvement.

SECTION II (COOPERATION)

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the Village of Ottoville, Ohio does hereby propose to cooperate with the State of Ohio, in the cost of the above described improvement, by assuming and contributing:

One Thousand Four Hundred and Two Dollars. (\$1402.00)

inclusive of the cost of engineering, preliminary contingencies and other incidental expenses.

SECTION III (a) (MAINTENANCE)

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Ottoville, Ohio, that upon completion of the aforementioned project by the Director of Highways, it is hereby understood and agreed that the Village of Ottoville, Ohio will maintain the project in a satisfactory manner and make ample provisions each year for such maintenance.

That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
