

ORDINANCE NO. 81

DETERMINING TO PROCEED WITH DRILLING A NEW WATER WELL

Be it ordained by the council of the Village of Ottoville, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That it is hereby determined to proceed with the drilling of a new water well to provide a more adequate supply of water for said Village, pursuant to and in accordance with the plans and specifications now on file with the Clerk of the Board of Public Affairs.

Section 2. That the cost of said water well shall be paid out of the Water fund.

Section 3. That the Board of Public Affairs be and hereby is authorized and directed to make and execute a contract for the drilling of said well with the lowest and best bidder, after advertisement, according to law.

Section 4. The ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary to the immediate protection of the public health, safety, and welfare and it shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the immediate necessity of obtaining an adequate supply of water for said Village.
