

TO VACATE CERTAIN ALLEYS

Whereas, on the 7th day of December, 1964, a petition by all of the persons in the immediate vicinity of certain alleys, between points named, be vacated; and

Whereas, Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made, now therefore,

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Ottoville, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the alley commencing at Kemper Street, bounded and described as follows:

Commencing for the same on the east line of Kemper Street, thence running east on the south line of Lot Number 214 to the southeast corner of said Lot; thence south along the west line of an alley running from Max Street to U. S. Route Number 224 to the northeast corner of Lot Number 213; thence west along the north line of said Lot Number 213 to Kemper Street; thence north along the east line of Kemper Street to the place of beginning,

be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. That the alley commencing at Kemper Street, bounded and described as follows:

Commencing for the same on the east line of Kemper Street, thence running east on the south line of Lot Number 212 to the southeast corner of said Lot; thence south along the west line of an alley running from Max Street to U. S. Route 224 to the northeast corner of Lot Number 211; thence west along the north line of said Lot Number 211 to Kemper Street; thence north along the east line of Kemper Street to the place of beginning,

be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 3. That part of the alley from Max Street to U. S. Route Number 224, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the west lot line of Inlot 291, said point being fifty feet south of the northwest corner of said Inlot 291, thence west to the east lot line of Inlot 215; thence south along the east lot lines of Inlots 215, 214, 213, 212, 211 and 210 to Max Street; thence east along the north line of Max Street to Inlot 287; thence north along the west lot line of Inlots 287, 288, 289, 290 and 291 to point and place of beginning,

be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 4. That this ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
