

ORDINANCE NO. 102

ACCEPTING APPLICATION FOR ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY

BE IT ORDAINED by Council of the Village of Ottoville, State of Ohio:

Section 1, That the application of Albert J. Winkelman and others for the annexation of the following described territory in the County of Putnam and adjacent to the Village of Ottoville, to-wit:

Situated in the Township of Monterey and known as:

Being a part of the northeast quarter of the southwest fractional quarter of Section 19, Monterey Township, Putnam County, Ohio and more particularly described: Commencing at a point 350.0 feet west of the southeast corner of the northeast quarter of the southwest fractional quarter of Section 19, thence north 0 degrees, 56 minutes east and parallel with the east side of the northeast quarter of the southwest fractional quarter of Section 19, 330.15 feet to the center of US Route 224, thence south 55 degrees, 35 minutes west along the center of said highway 583.9 feet, thence east 476.33 feet to the place of beginning. Containing 1.80 acres more or less,

an accurate map of which territory, together with the petition for its annexation and other papers relating thereto, and a certified transcript of the proceedings of the County Commissioners in relation thereto are on file with the clerk of the council of said village, be and the same is hereby accepted.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
