

ORDINANCE NO. 174

AN ORDINANCE DETERMINING TO PROCEED WITH CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS TO THE WATER TREATMENT SYSTEM AND AUTHORIZING THE PREPARATION OF ENGINEERING PLANS AND OTHER SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Council deems it necessary to proceed with certain improvements to water treatment system,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Ottoville, Ohio:

Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized to enter into a contract with E. C. Gerken & Associates, Inc. to provide the required engineering services to develop construction plans, specifications and cost estimates and provide construction inspection and supervision as required for the improvement of the water treatment system.

Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to enter into the necessary agreement with the Ohio Water Development Authority (OWDA) for the financing at these improvements.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Village of Ottoville, Ohio, and for the further reason that the improvements are necessary to assure an adequate safe water system wherefor this Ordinance shall be in effect and in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
