

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF 1983 CDBG SMALL CITIES COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT GRANT DOCUMENTS AND AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT FOR STORM SEWER IMPROVEMENTS IN OTTOVILLE, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Ottoville, Ohio deems it necessary to improve the storm sewer collection system; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Ottoville, Ohio has been granted a \$15,000 Block Grant from HUD through the Putnam County Commissioners and has allocated \$15,000.00 of local funds for the project; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development has enacted the Small Cities - Discretionary Grant Program which provides funding for single purpose community development needed for deficiencies in public facilities which affect the public health, safety and welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Ottoville, Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute 1983 CDBG Small Cities Community Development Grant agreements and documents with the Putnam County Commissioners administering the 1983 HUD CDBG program on behalf of the Ohio Department of Development for funding improvements to the Storm Sewer Collection System.

Section 2: That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with E. C. Gerken & Associates, Inc. to provide the necessary planning and engineering services to prepare construction plans and specifications and perform all necessary construction services.

Section 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Village of Ottoville, Ohio, and for the further reason that the immediate adoption of this Ordinance is necessary so the Application can be completed to reserve the funds, wherefor this Ordinance shall be in full effect and force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
