

ORDINANCE NO. 275

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING LIFT STATIONS BUILT
IN THE FUTURE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Ottoville, Ohio, three-fourths of its members concurring hereto that:

Section 1. From the effective date of this ordinance, all lift stations built by private developers within the Village of Ottoville, Ohio, shall be constructed with pumps and motors installed above ground as an aid in the inspection and maintenance of said lift stations.

Section 2. The pumps and motors installed in the lift stations mentioned in Section 1 hereof shall be only of those types authorized by the Board of Trustees of Public Affairs for the Village of Ottoville, Ohio.

Section 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the health, sanitation, and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Ottoville, Ohio. Therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately.
