ORDINANCE NO. 294

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRUCK
PARKING IN THE VILLAGE OF OTTOVILLE, OHIO

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Ottoville,
State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to park or leave standing a Class A truck, Class B truck, semi-tractor, semi-trailer, or dump truck upon the streets and alleys of the Village of Ottoville, for more than 15 minutes except where the truck is disabled while on the streets and alleys of said Village of Ottoville or where the truck is being loaded or unloaded or at a work site involving the use of the truck.

SECTION 2. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) for a first offense and for the second and subsequent convictions within one year thereafter by a fine of not more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 115 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate protection of the public health, safety, and welfare, and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity of preventing driving hazards created by the parking of semi-trailers and preventing damage to the streets and alleys of said village.
